# Fruit Attraction 2025 - Madrid

We had the pleasure of attending Fruit Attraction 2025 in Madrid, one of the leading events in the fruit and vegetable industry. The knowledge gained and relationships built now form the foundation of our strategy to strengthen our market position and drive growth.



# New carton

We are pleased to announce the creation of the groundbreaking, innovative YELLOW banana carton, developed through a strategic collaboration with Mondi and Incarpalm.

This partnership proves that thinking “outside the box” can be taken literally! Our new carton is just as durable, made with approximately 40% recycled fiber, and up to 10% lighter than the previous design. This reduced weight directly contributes to lower CO2 emissions during transport, without compromising banana protection. The logistics process is optimized: paper bales shipped from Poland to Ecuador return the same way as yellow cartons filled with fruit.



# Visit to BART

We visited the BART factory – our trusted supplier of tomato packaging! We had the opportunity to see firsthand how our packaging is made, and Marcin Dynowski guided us through the facility, explaining the production processes and how the machines operate in detail. It was a truly inspiring visit! Additionally, we took part in tests of new tomato cartons, which you'll soon be able to find in retail chains and wholesale markets.



# MON Recognition for Citronex


# Cracow independent Run

# Forum de Bun si Bine

We thank Calin Costinas for the invitation to the highly inspiring “Forum de Bun si Bine” event in Bucharest. Marek Szulc, Rafał Zarzecki, and Grzegorz Karolczak were deeply impressed by Profi’s strategy for developing rural areas in Romania. We share this vision and are backing it with concrete actions: we are beginning the construction of a modern 10-hectare greenhouse in Dubrăveni, a region with a tradition of tomato cultivation. This investment will create new jobs and enable year-round production of Romanian tomatoes, as the greenhouses will be equipped with advanced lighting systems. We hope that local pride in domestic production will replace imports. Together, we will work toward a better Romania.



# Seedling Production Plant

We have begun construction of one of the most modern plant multiplication facilities in Poland – covering 7 hectares with 11 climate-controlled greenhouses. We focus on automation and safety, using, among other solutions, ozonation instead of traditional disinfection, ensuring the highest quality and minimizing disease risks. Our goal is to combine technological innovation with excellent crop quality. We are currently looking for specialists to work in comfortable, safe conditions in line with European standards. The investment is already underway – we invite you to follow its progress!

# Audits - GLOBALG.A.P. i GRASP

External GLOBALG.A.P. and GRASP Audits Confirm High Standards in Our Tomato Companies

In recent weeks, our tomato companies underwent their annual external GLOBALG.A.P. and GRASP audits, confirming the quality of production and responsible social practices. The audits were conducted at three locations:

PPO Siechnice – October 29, 2025

Polskie Pomidory S.A., Bogatynia – November 25, 2025

Polskie Pomidory S.A., Ryczywół – December 4, 2025

We are pleased to report that no non-conformities were found at any of the locations, confirming the high level of care for food safety, the environment, and working conditions.

The GLOBALG.A.P. standard verifies responsible production management, plant protection, resource management, and product safety, while the GRASP module focuses on social aspects, including labor rights, communication, and employment conditions.

We thank our employees for their professional preparation and for consistently maintaining the highest standards.

The end of 2025 brought excellent results for our companies in a series of external audits, confirming that food quality and safety are the foundation of our operations.

On 1-2 December 2025, an IFS Food audit was conducted at PPO Siechnice and was completed at the higher level. Both Citronex I locations also achieved outstanding results, maintaining IFS Food certification at the higher level and BRCGS for Food Safety certification at level A+ – one of the highest possible – during unannounced audits.
